

Instructions for Poster Presentations

All posters will be on display from the morning of Thursday, June 2, through the evening of Friday, June 3. While conference attendees will be able to view posters at any time that is convenient, there are dedicated viewing times: from 4:30-5:30 pm on June 2 and from 4:30-6:00 pm on June 3. Each presenter will be assigned to one of the two viewing times to maximize interactions with other scientists. You must attend your poster during your assigned time, but you are also free to be there at any other time. The Galleria, where the posters will be displayed, will be open during all conference hours.

Instructions:

- Posters will be displayed on framed boards that are 4 feet by 8 feet, but presenters will share this space such that 4 posters are displayed on each board (front and back). Therefore, the posters should be prepared in portrait orientation (vertical). The posters should be no more than 36 inches (91 cm) wide by 44 inches (112 cm) long.
- Be sure that all text on your poster is readable from 4-5 feet away.
- Posters that present data derived from human subjects or research involving animals **must** include statement(s) that the protocols were approved by an Institutional Review Board.
- Images that depict inhumane treatment of animals **are not allowed** under any circumstances.
- Include all sources of research support directly on your poster.
